Program Overview

HHS Center Au Pair programs offered here are: language partner Au Pair and childcare Au Pair. The program duration is 3,6, or 12 months. The placement cities are **Beijing, Qingdao, Changsha, Guangzhou, Kunming, Shanghai, Wuhan and Chongqing.**

The aims of the HHS Au Pair program are to help young people from overseas to see a real China, and learn authentic Chinese from native Chinese people while doing the childcare with some light housework. It also has the added convenience of free room and board. There are opportunities for language classes, going to musical and theatrical performances, tasting authentic Chinese food, and cultural classes such as water painting and calligraphy.

Conditions for Participation

- Age: 18-29
- Be fluent in English without strong accent (preferably native English speaker), Chinese language ability is **NOT** necessary.
- Must be in good health, and with a clear criminal record
